Interim Information (II) Settlement Re-Runs

What is happening?

If a Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator (NHHDA) does not submit data for a Settlement Date, the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent (SVAA) will use default data to avoid zero data entering Settlement.

The SVAA was unable to use default data in Settlement calculations between **29 March 2018** and **5 April 2018 (excluding 3 April)** due to a system issue. For these dates, where a NHHDA did not submit data, zero metered volumes were used. In order to correct this issue and avoid any impact on Settlement, Settlement Re-Runs were completed on **13 and 14 April 2018**.

How will I be impacted?

The NHHDA's subsequently submitted most of the missing data which was used for the Settlement Re-Runs. The Settlement Administration Agent (SAA) Reports have been issued with corrected metered volumes and as a result, there should be no impact on Settlement.

Is there anything else I need to know?

ELEXON is still missing some data from three NHHDA's (UDMS, HYDE, SOUT) for Settlement Date **4 April 2018**, and the SVAA has used default data (3 April 2018) as required. The NHHDA's have been notified and we are working to resolve the SVAA system issue to prevent further re-occurrence.
